We thank God that the International Lutheran Seafarers Mission was granted a center in Jurong Fishery Port. Rev Christian Schmidt and Ps Wilson Wong worked very hard to get this center for the welfare of the seafarers so that they can rest and connect with their family and friends. The center will need some volunteers and if you would like to help please contact Rev Christian Schmidt and Ps Wilson Wong. We also thank God that the Seafarers Mission received a van for transport use. It will be of tremendous help for their ministry of caring for the seafarers who sacrifice so much so that we can get our goods.

God has granted faith to many Cambodians as they heard the Gospel. On 1 January 2012 about 33 Cambodians were baptized. These included the first batch of 12 students from the LWM(Lutheran World Mission) hostel in Phnom Penh. We need to buy hostels so that this effective ministry to the University students can continue on. The hostels that we were renting were sold so we had to find other hostels. Thank God that this happened when Sally Kee was in Myanmar for meeting with the partner churches of the Mekong Mission. She shared this with the members of the partner churches and they were willing to offer support. The hostels could cost around USD 200,000. Please pray that the Lord will supply the finance needed to purchase the hostels.

Sally Kee was invited by the Finnish Evangelical Lutheran Missions to share about the Cambodia work in their Missions Festival in June.

Rev Jimmy Khoo and his family returned to Singapore from Mongolia on 21 June. They are back for their daughter, Janice's medical appointment. Rev Jimmy Khoo preached at the Lutheran church of Our Redeemer on 1July. He will return to teach at the Mongolian International University in mid August. Rev Jimmy Khoo had a fruitful time in teaching the lay leaders during his vacation. Jennifer was invited to share with the church women. Please continue to pray for them regarding Janice's medical follow up and for a

refreshing time in Singapore before they return to Mongolia.
