

The Holy Spirit and God's Mission

God's church does not have a mission: God's mission has a church.

God's church does not have a mission: God's mission has a church. God's active engagement in the world precedes the church's engagement with it. Every element of the biblical narrative – from creation to new creation – emphasises the primacy of God's work, over ours. We are therefore participants in his mission. That means we are not the active agents, he is. It rules out any form of dualism or deism; and places us fair and square in dependence on God the Spirit, who is his active agent of mission in the world. This understanding transforms everything, from the way we do our planning (planning as discernment), to the way we pray (seeking where he is already at work), to the expectancy we have of the harvest (he has already gone ahead of us, "into Galilee"). This seminar explores these themes from a variety of angles and opens up discussion about the way we approach ministry at every level.
